

Opioid and NSAID or Aspirin combinations

Brand	Generic	Available Strengths
Vicoprofen	Hydrocodone/Ibuprofen	7.5 mg/200 mg tablets
Initially hailed as a safer option for patients at risk of Acetaminophen-mediated liver toxicity.		
Ibudone	Hydrocodone/Ibuprofen	10-200 mg tablets 5-200 mg tablets
200 mg of Ibuprofen taken 8 times a day could easily produce severe GI toxicity.		
Percodan	oxycodone/aspirin	4.835/325 mg tablets
Still commonly prescribed by physicians that may not always be aware of the clinical risks associated with this powerful C-II Opioid and the dangers of using multiple daily doses of Aspirin instead of using acetaminophen based (e.g., Percocet) products.		
Soma Compound with Codeine	Carisoprodol, Aspirin, Codeine	200 mg of carisoprodol, 325 mg of aspirin, 16 mg of codeine phosphate.
Centrally acting muscle relaxant could increase the risk of dizziness and balance issues especially in the elderly= increased risk of bleeding could increase with falling.		
Fiorinal with Codeine	butalbital aspirin caffeine codeine phosphate	butalbital 50 mg aspirin 325 mg caffeine 40 mg codeine phosphate 30 mg
Use commonly for headaches including migraine or tension headaches.		
Empirin with Codeine	<i>Aspirin/Codeine</i>	325 mg / 30 mg or 60 mg
May not be available anymore in the U.S.-But still is utilized around the world. Available OTC in some countries.
